BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The Classification Plan is being amended for the purpose of assigning certain existing classes of work to the bargaining unit represented by the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. in accordance with the certification of representation issued by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board in AAA Case Number 16 39 00121 89W. This legislation also accompanies the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Prince George's County and the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. for certain Food Services employees. The fiscal impact will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
