Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Harrison, Glaros, Patterson and Toles)

Council staff gave an overview of the purpose of the resolution. CR-18-2018 provides for a transfer of certain appropriations and expenditures between certain programs in the FY2017-2018 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund. The proposed adjustments include a transfer in the amount of \$7,500.00 from the Daughter for the Day Program (Senior Services) – District 7 project to two recreation programs also designated in District 7 – 100 Black Men of Prince George's County and Foundation for the Advancement of Music and Education (FAME).

Council Member Toles, the sponsor of the resolution, informed the Committee that since the Daughter for the Day Program has ceased operation, it is necessary to transfer the funding allocation from this program prior to the end of the fiscal year. Ms. Toles explained that the two other recreation programs, which will each receive an allocation of \$3,750, currently provide special services in her district.

The Office of Law reviewed CR-18-2018 and found it in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Committee voted favorable on the resolution as drafted.
