RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Compensation and Benefits - Council 67,

American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees,

AFL-CIO, and its affiliated Local 3279

(Department of Environmental Resources-Clerical Units I and II)

For the purpose of amending the Salary Plan of the County to reflect an amendment to the terms of a labor agreement, by and between Prince George's County and AFSCME Local 3279.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 903 of Article IX of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of the Prince George's County Code, amendments to the County's Salary Plan are to be submitted to the County Council in resolution form; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section VI of Salary Schedule C submitted and recommended by the County Executive on June 10, 1998, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, setting forth the following modification: providing for a July 1998 effective date for the 2.75% cost of living increase, be and the same is hereby approved.
