# IMPACT



## Phase IV (May 2021 through January 2022)

- **Grocery Food Boxes (Perishable and Non-Perishable)** – 109,500 boxes or 2,190,000 LBs to provide approximately 587,900 Meals
  - **Prepared Meals** – approximately 39,900
  - **Food Distribution Sites** – 16 Non-Profit Organizations

## Phases I, II and III (May 2020 through April 2021)

- **Grocery Food Boxes (Perishable and Non-Perishable)** – 225,600 boxes or 4,511,500 LBs to provide approximately 1,211,000 Meals
  - **Prepared Meals** – approximately 114,000
  - **Food Distribution Sites** – 21 Non-Profit Organizations

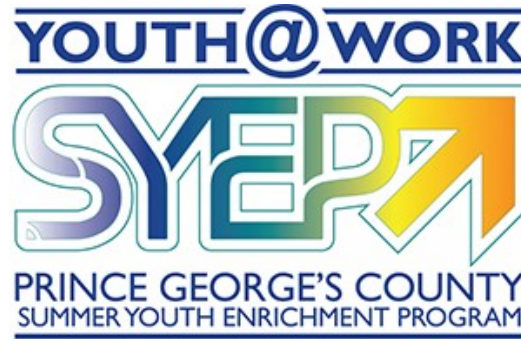

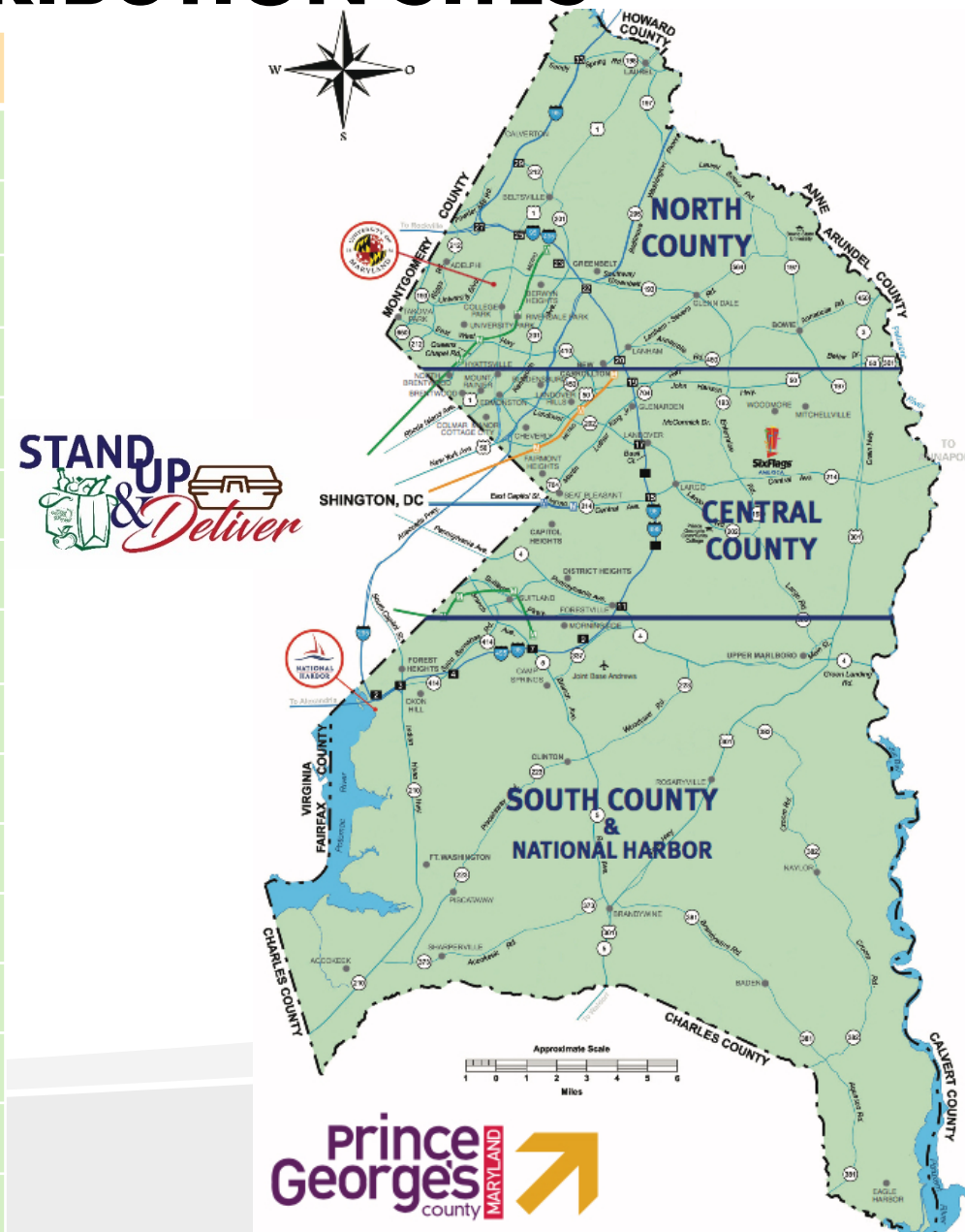

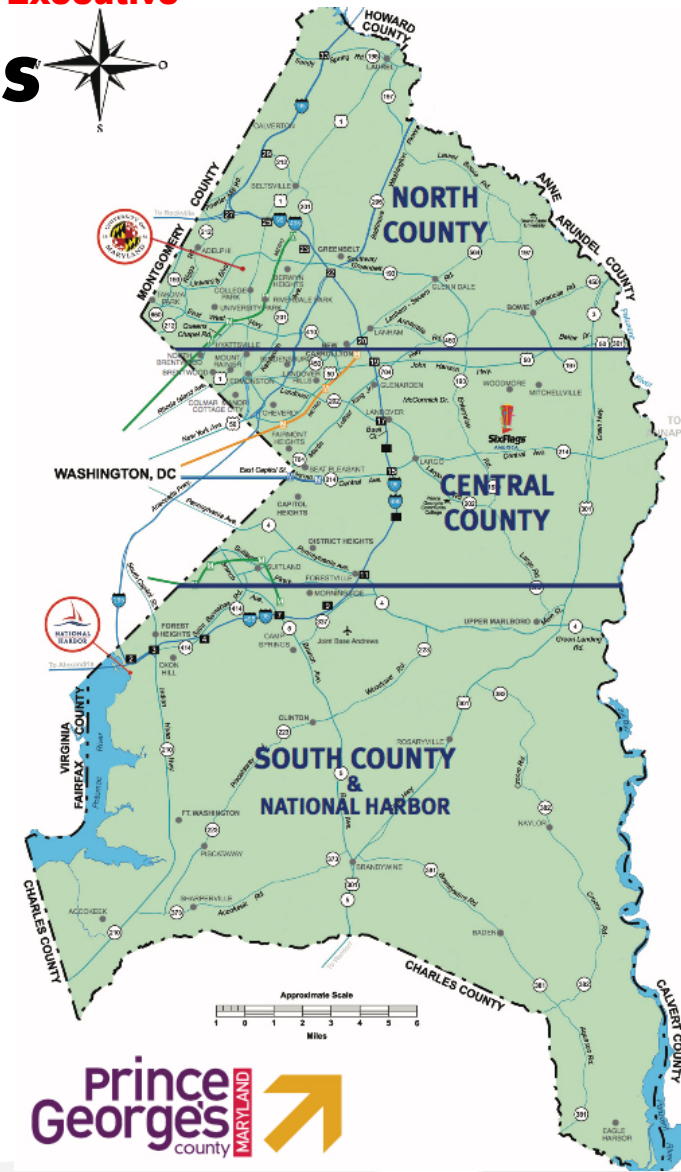
