For the purpose	of urging Federal officials to oppose efforts to negate State and local authority to
protect borrower	rs from predatory lending practices.
WHEREAS	S, the County Council believes that predatory lending abuses that take away
homeowner's eq	uity and lock borrowers into high interest rates are pervasive throughout the
subprime mortga	age market; and
WHEREAS	S, Fannie Mae estimates that up to half of borrowers in subprime loans could
qualify for loans	with substantially lower rates and fees; and
WHEREAS	S, the targeting of subprime loans to people of color, low and moderate income
families, and ser	nior citizens costs those who can least afford it a great deal of money each year
and reverses har	d-won progress that has been made on reducing the racial homeownership gap;
and	
WHEREAS	S, many states and localities have responded to this situation protecting their
residents with la	ws that provide critical safeguards on high-cost home loans without cutting off
access to credit,	thereby preventing many predatory loans; and
WHEREAS	S, there are proposals for Federal legislation to negate all State and local anti-
predatory lendin	g laws without providing any meaningful, new protections for consumers.
NOW, THI	EREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that members of the United States Congress be urged to respect the authority

of State and local officials to protect their constituents from predatory home loans that strip away

1	hard-earned home equity, trap borrowers in excessive interest rates, and frequently cause	
2	families to lose their homes.	
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the United States	
4	Senators and members of Congress from Maryland.
