Except when located on a tract of land which is less than 1.5 acres in size and surrounded on all sides by land in any residential zone in order to ensure safety on contiguous parcels and to minimize negative aesthetic impact on neighboring areas. A maximum of one [(1)] monopole and [two (2)] antennas for four carriers are permitted. For any use for which the original permit was applied for prior to November 25, 1997, and legally issued, telecommunications-related equipment may be moved inside an existing structure without obtaining a special exception for the alteration of a nonconforming use. (CB-102-1997; CB-38-1998)

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-fiv
(45) calendar days after its adoption.
