BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed resolution allows for the issuance of a Use and Occupancy to be issued on a temporary basis for a private school to be located in an existing structure without first obtaining a special exception under certain circumstances. The particular circumstances necessitating the approval of the resolution arise out of a fire that damaged and destroyed portions of a church that housed a private school on December 9, 2003. Unless the school can relocate and begin classes expeditiously, the enrolled students will be unable to meet State-mandated days of instruction for the academic year. All other laws relating to safety and occupancy by student in a school setting will be required.
