12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
13	Maryland, that Section 10A-158.00.03 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is
14	hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

20	(a) All Department of Prince George's County Department of Public Works and
21	Transportation CIP 4.66.0002 Curb and Road and Rehabilitation 2 projects shall require, as part

of a solicitation for a construction contract, that every contractor and subcontractor that will engage in the construction project agree to negotiate or become a party to a project labor agreement, for that project, with one or more labor organizations if:

(1) Use of a project labor agreement will advance the County's interest in producing labor-management stability and ensuring compliance with laws and regulations governing safety and health, equal employment opportunity, labor and employment standards, and other matters.

(b) A project labor agreement agreed to pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall:

(1) Bind all contractors and subcontractors engaged in construction on the construction project to comply with the project labor agreement; and

(2) Contain guarantees against strikes, lockouts, and similar job disruptions; and

(3) Set forth effective, prompt, and mutually binding procedures for resolving labor disputes arising during the term of the project labor agreement; and

(4) Provide other mechanisms for labor-management cooperation on matters of mutual interest and concern, including productivity, quality of work, safety, and health; and

(5) Include any additional requirements that the Office of Central Services considers necessary to promote the County's interest.

(c) The Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation may waive the requirement for contractors or subcontractors to negotiate or enter into a project labor agreement for construction projects under CIP 4.66.0002 Curb and Road and Rehabilitation 2, if:

(1) The Department conducts a competitive solicitation process for the project; and

(2) The Department determines, based on the response to the solicitation, that no gualified vendors are willing to participate under a project labor agreement.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

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SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on forty-fiv
