For the purpose of adop	oting and publishing the 2003 Edition of the Prince George's County
Code.	
	BY compiling, codifying, adopting and publishing:
	The Prince George's County Code
	(2003 Edition).
WHEREAS, Artic	ele III, Section 321 of the Charter for Prince George's County provides
that the County Counci	l, at intervals not greater than every four years, shall compile, codify,
adopt, and publish a Co	ode of the laws of the County; and
WHEREAS, the C	County Code was last published as the 1999 Edition; and
WHEREAS, it is	informative to the citizens of the County to append to the County Code
the provisions of the Co	ounty Charter and Laws relating to the Washington Suburban Transit
District; therefore	
SECTION 1. BE	IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, that the Prin	ce George's County Code, 2003 Edition, is hereby compiled, codified,
adopted, and published	:
(a) On and after t	the effective date of this Act, the Prince George's County Code, 2003
Edition, consisting of S	subtitles 1 through 23, Subtitles 24A through 26A, and Subtitles 28
through 31, together wi	th any additional Subtitles which may hereafter be enacted and any

1	current Supplement to the County Code which may be issued, shall be, with respect to the matter	
2	set forth therein:	
3	(1) Conclusive evidence of the text of the Prince George's County Code and all	
4	enactments dated on or before November 30, 1999.	
5	(2) Prima facie evidence of:	
6	(A) The Prince George's County Charter, together with all amendments, and the	
7	Schedule of Legislation accompanying the Charter.	
8	(B) Article 17 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland as enacted by the General	
9	Assembly of Maryland.	
10	(C) All other County acts, ordinances, Code provisions, resolutions having the	
11	force of law, and all other legislation enacted or adopted after November 30, 2003.	
12	(b) Supplements to the Prince George's County Code, 2003 Edition, shall be published at	
13	least annually.	
14	(c) The words "County Code" or "Code" shall be taken to mean the Prince George's	
15	County Code, 2003 Edition, together with any current Supplement, unless the content clearly	
16	requires otherwise.	
17	(d) The 2003 Edition of the Code supersedes previous editions thereof.	
18	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2003 Edition of the Prince George's	
19	County Code shall take effect on the effective date of this Act. The master copy of the 2003	
20	Edition of the Code shall be authenticated by the Legislative Officer and delivered as a public	
21	record to the Clerk of the Council. The Clerk shall maintain that master copy together with any	
22	Supplements thereto. A copy of the 2003 Edition of the Code shall be available at the County	
23	Documents Reference Library for public use during normal working hours.	
24	SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Legislative Officer is authorized to	
25	compile and publish an abridged edition of the County Code containing the following subtitles	
26	pertaining to land use, construction standards, and real estate development:	
27	Subtitle 4. Building	
28	Subtitle 5B. Chesapeake Bay Critical Area	
29	Subtitle 9. Electricity	
30	Subtitle 11. Fire Safety (code only)	
31	Subtitle 17. Plumbing and Gas Fitting

7	SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the general penalty provided in Section		
8	1-123 of the County Code shall apply to every offense or violation made unlawful by the County		
9	Code unless a specific penalty therefor is otherwise provided.		
10	SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)		
11	calendar days after it becomes law.
