3	(b) Expansion of Intense Development and Limited Development Overlay Zones.
4	(1) The boundaries of the Intense Development and Limited Development Overlay
5	Zones may be expanded within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area only in accordance with the
6	following:
7	(A) Acreage. The maximum area of future additional Intense Development or
8	Limited Development Overlay Zones shall be five percent (5%) of the total area designated as
9	Resource Conservation Overlay Zones at the time of adoption of the initial Chesapeake Bay
10	Critical Area Overlay Zoning Map Amendment. A maximum of fifty percent (50%) of the
11	permissible growth increment may be used to rezone a Resource Conservation Overlay Zone to
12	another Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone.
13	(B) Location. Expanded Intense Development or Limited Development Overlay
14	Zones may be approved subject to the following locational criteria:
15	(i) New Intense Development Overlay Zones shall:
16	(aa) Be located in existing Limited Development Overlay Zones or
