## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

In 1996, the County Council initiated an effort to develop a Countywide Growth Policy and Strategic Economic Development Plan. By adoption of CR-18-1997, the Council established a 7-member Interagency Work Group and a 17-member Task Force to assist in this effort. The concepts of the Growth Policy that were reviewed and commented on by the Work Group and Task Force are

supported by the Council. This resolution directs the Prince George's County Planning Department of the Maryland-National Capital Park & Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) to prepare legislation that will embody the overall concept and establish a growth management program for Prince George's County.
