BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Property Tax - Installment Payment Schedule

3 For the purpose of establishing an installment payment schedule for County, municipal, and
4 special taxing district property taxes due on owner-occupied residential property owned by a
5 homeowner if the homeowner is at least 62 years old and the property is not subject to a deed of
6 trust, mortgage, or other encumbrance; providing for election of an installment payment
7 schedule; providing for the due date of each payment installment; and generally relating to a
8 property tax installment payment schedule.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
15 Maryland, that Section 10-198 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
16 added:

17 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

18 DIVISION 8. TAX ASSESSMENT, LEVY, AND COLLECTION.

19 SUBDIVISION 1A. PROPERTY TAX.

20 **Sec. 10-198. Property tax; installment payment schedule.**

21 (a) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

1 (1) "Owner-occupied residential property" means the principal residence of a homeowner as
2 defined in § 9-105 of the Tax-Property Article.

3 (b) Pursuant to §10-204.3(k) of the Tax-Property Article of the Maryland Annotated Code,
4 there is established an installment payment schedule of four payments each year for County,
5 municipal, and special taxing district property taxes due on owner-occupied residential property
6 owned by the homeowner if:

- 7 (1) the homeowner is at least 62 years old; and
- 8 (2) the owner-occupied residential property is not subject to a deed of trust, mortgage,
9 or other encumbrance.

10 (c) An installment payment schedule under this section shall apply:

- 11 (1) at the time of the transfer of property purchased on or after July 1, 2013; and
- 12 (2) to any current or future owner of owner-occupied residential property regardless of
13 whether the property was purchased before July 1, 2013.

14 (d) (1) The installment payment schedule under this section shall apply to:

- 15 (i) the property tax due for the tax year following transfer of the property; and
- 16 (ii) the property tax due and not in arrears for the current tax year for any transfer occurring
17 on or after July 1 but on or before September 30.

18 (e) A payment under the installment payment schedule:

19 (1) For the first installment:

- 20 (i) is due on July 1 of the tax year; and
- 21 (ii) may be paid without interest on or before September 30 of the tax year;

22 (2) A payment under the installment payment schedule:

23 For the second installment:

- 24 (i) is due on December 1 of the tax year; and
- 25 (ii) may be paid without interest on or before December 31 of the tax year.

26 (2) A payment under the installment payment schedule:

27 For the third installment:

- 28 (i) is due on January 1 of the tax year; and
- 29 (ii) may be paid without interest on or before January 31 of the tax year.

30 (3) A payment under the installment payment schedule:

31 For the fourth installment:

- 1 (iii) is due on February 1 of the tax year; and
- 2 (iv) may be paid without interest on or before February 28 of the tax year.
- 3 (f) The installment payment schedule may include a service charge to be paid with the
- 4 fourth installment.

5 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on forty-five (45)
 6 calendar days after it becomes law and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after
 7 June 30, 2013.
