BILL

AN ACT concerning

Casino Night Levy

For the purpose of establishing and imposing a graduated casino night levy on gross receipts derived during the fiscal year from gaming activities conducted at a casino night.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

Section 10-271, _____ The Prince

George's County Code

(1991 Edition, 1994 Supplement,
as amended by CB-44-1995).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 10-271 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

DIVISION 13. CASINO NIGHT LEVY.

Sec. 10-271. Casino night levy.

(a) There is hereby established and imposed a graduated casino night levy [of twenty percent (20%) of the] on gross receipts derived during the fiscal year from gaming activities conducted at a casino night by an organization pursuant to Section 5-118.01 of this Code to be expended for general purposes. The levy is imposed as follows: five percent (5%) on the first

Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or any lesser amount of gross receipts cumulatively derived during the fiscal year; ten percent (10%) on gross receipts in excess of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) up to Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) cumulatively derived during the fiscal year; and twenty percent (20%) on all gross receipts in excess of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) cumulatively derived during the fiscal year. The levy imposed in this Division is in addition to the fees established pursuant to Section 5-118.04 of this Code.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect January 1, 1996. This Act shall have no retroactive application prior to that date for purposes of applying the provisions of this Act. In Fiscal Year 1996 only, the amount of the levy shall be based upon the gross receipts cumulatively derived during the last six months of Fiscal Year 1996. In each fiscal year thereafter, the amount of the levy shall be based upon the gross receipts cumulatively derived during the entire fiscal year.
