BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Hotel and Motel Tax

3 For the purpose of repealing the requirement that a portion of the County's revenue from the
 4 imposition of the hotel and motel tax be reserved for appropriation to the Prince George's
 5 Conference and Visitors Bureau.

6 BY repealing:

7 Chapter 23, Laws of Prince George's County, 1993

8 Section 2.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 10 Maryland, that Section 2 of Chapter 23, Laws of Prince George's County, 1993, as enacted by
 11 CB-17-1993, be and the same is hereby repealed:

12 [SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that, effective July 1, 1994, of the revenue
 13 attributable to a two and one-half percent (2 ½%) hotel and motel tax rate, twenty percent (20%)
 14 of such revenue shall be reserved for appropriation to the Prince George's Conference and
 15 Visitors Bureau to be used to promote travel to the County.]

16 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
 17 calendar days after it becomes law and the provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall be effective
 18 July 1, 2000.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the level of funding in the proposed
 operating budget of the County for the Prince George's Conference and Visitors Bureau shall be
 at a level comparable to the amount appropriated in FY2000.
