CHARTER AMENDMENT

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amendment of Section 507, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 507 of the Charter of Prince George's
4 County to provide notice and hearing requirements and County Council approval of any
5 proposed removal of members from County boards and commissions.

6 BY proposing an amendment to:

7 Section 507,

8 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
10 Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 507, Charter of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, is hereby proposed:

12 **Section 507. Removal of Members of Boards and Commissions.**

13 Except for members of the Personnel Board established by Section 906 of this Charter, the
14 Board of Ethics as established by Section 1001, and except as otherwise provided for by State
15 law, a member of any appointed board or commission may be removed from office [by the
16 County Executive] for cause, upon recommendation of the County Executive and a public
17 hearing held thereon, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the County Council.

18 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the
19 County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors
20 of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2004
21 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.
