SECTION 1. BE IT EN	NACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,	
Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 507, Charter of Prince George's County,		
Maryland, is hereby propose	d:	
Section 507. Removal of M	lembers of Boards and Commissions.	
Except for members of	the Personnel Board established by Section 906 of this Charter, the	
Board of Ethics as establishe	d by Section 1001, and except as otherwise provided for by State	
law, a member of any appoir	ated board or commission may be removed from office [by the	
County Executive] for cause	, upon recommendation of the County Executive and a public	
hearing held thereon, subject	to confirmation by a majority vote of the County Council.	
SECTION 2. BE IT FU	JRTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the	
County Executive for publication	ation and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors	
of Elections for submission of	of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2004	
General Election pursuant to	Section 1105 of the Charter.
