BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 2021-2022 Compensation Review Board - Revised Appointments

3 For the purpose of revising certain appointments to the Compensation Review Board; and
4 generally regarding the Compensation Review Board.

5 WHEREAS, State and County law provide for the appointment of a Compensation Review
6 Board; and

7 WHEREAS, Section 10-302, Local Government I Article, Annotated Code of Maryland
8 provides that, by ordinance, a county may establish a commission to recommend compensation
9 and allowances for members of the county legislative body; and

10 WHEREAS, Section 10-303, Local Government I Article, Annotated Code of Maryland
11 provides that the county may set the qualifications, term of office, and compensation for the
12 county executive; and

13 WHEREAS, Charter Section 308 and Charter Section 406 require that a compensation
14 review board be appointed by the Council and the County Executive not later than December 15
15 of the last year of the term to study the rate of current compensation for Council members and
16 the County Executive; and

17 WHEREAS, the 2021-2022 Compensation Review Board was established, pursuant to CR-
18 1-2021, and the establishment of the 2021-2022 Compensation Review Board was ratified, by
19 ordinance, by CB-2-2021, pursuant to Section 10-302, Local Government I Article, Annotated
20 Code of Maryland; and

21 WHEREAS, subsequent to the enactment of CB-2-2021, the County Council and County

1 Executive were advised that an appointee, a designee of the County Executive, was unable to
 2 serve; and

3 WHEREAS, there is a need to appoint an alternate member of the Compensation Review
 4 Board.

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 6 Maryland, that the 2021-2022 Compensation Review Board was established, pursuant to CR-1-
 7 2021, and was ratified, by ordinance, CB-2-2021, pursuant to Section 10-302, Local Government
 8 I Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

9 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2021-2022 Compensation Review
 10 Board shall consist of seven (7) citizens, three (3) appointed by the County Council and three (3)
 11 appointed by the County Executive, and one (1) Chairperson, who shall be jointly agreed upon
 12 by the County Executive and the Chair of the County Council.

13 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the appointees to the 2021-2022
 14 Compensation Review Board will also serve as members of the 2021-2022 Charter Review
 15 Commission.

16 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that subsequent to the enactment of CB-2-
 17 2021, the County Council and County Executive were advised that an appointee, a designee of
 18 the County Executive, was unable to serve and there is a need to appoint an alternate member of
 19 the Compensation Review Board.

20 SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that Mr. Dennis Brownlee, a designee of the
 21 County Executive, is hereby appointed to the Compensation Review Board.

22 SECTION 6. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the 2021-2022 Compensation Review
 23 Board shall consist of the following seven citizens: The Honorable Camille A Exum, The
 24 Honorable Samuel H. Dean, Dr. Stephanie Stanard, appointed by the County Council, Mr.
 25 Dennis Brownlee, Ms. Glenda R. Wilson, and Ms. Jacqueline B. Woody, appointed by the
 26 County Executive, and The Honorable Chairperson Lupi Grady, jointly agreed upon by the
 27 County Executive and the Chair of the County Council.

28 SECTION 7. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
 29 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
 30 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
 31 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining

1 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
2 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
3 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
4 or section.

5 SECTION 8. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
6 calendar days after it becomes law.
