

Campus Improvement and Women's Health

The following is a fact sheet summarizing Campus Improvement and Women's Health CON

Our goal is to provide needed access and compassionate care to our community by expanding and renovating the Doctors Community Medical Center facilities.

Women's Services Goals

- Respond to the need in Prince George's County for a delivery site close to home.
- Reallocate resources to improve access, meet local demand, increase patient satisfaction.
- Improve access to achieve improved maternal and infant outcomes.
- Improve management of chronic conditions to minimize risks and improve maternal health outcomes.
- Attract more quality physicians to Prince George's County

Obstetrics:

LHDCMC will develop an obstetric program that will deliver 2,500 births annually. Included:

- Labor and Delivery and Mother/Baby Units will cover two floors of the new pavilion
- 36 licensed beds
- Two dedicated C-Section operating rooms
- Affiliated sterile processing capacity
- Level II Special Care Nursery

Capital Improvement

Facilities:

LHDCMC proposes to expand, upgrade, and renovate the existing hospital building as follows:

- Facility expansion proposed is a four-story building.
- First floor will allow for expansion and renovation of support services to include:
 - Laboratory
 - Pharmacy
 - Central sterile processing
 - Food and nutrition
 - Loading dock
- Floors two and three will accommodate inpatient space for the proposed new obstetrical services
- Facility improvements also include site work, such as roads and additional parking
- Fourth Floor consists of a mechanical penthouse

Timeline:

- Inpatient Bed **Submission** of CON Application Spring 2021
- First baby delivered 2024
