BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation will allow certain defined mobile food vendors to locate, pursuant to a temporary, on private property. There are restrictions on the permissible locations and a requirement that written permission of the owner of the property be obtained. Also, the permissible locations are concentrated on the four most-dense urban Census Tracts, all of which are in the 2nd Councilmanic District.
