A RESOLUTION concerning

District Council Rules of Procedure

For the purpose of amending the Rules of Procedure for the District Council, concerning procedures for judicial review of District Council actions.

WHEREAS, Section 316 of the Charter for Prince George's County provides for the County Council to adopt and publish rules; and

WHEREAS, the County Council Rules of Procedure, as adopted in CR-1-1995, are applicable to proceedings of the County Council sitting as the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the Rules of Procedure for the District Council were adopted in CR-5-1993 and have been amended in CR-2-1994, CR-2-1995, and CR-74-1995, to provide supplemental rules which pertain to the unique operations of the District Council and to restate portions of the Rules of Procedure which apply to operations of the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the District Council has determined that its Rules of Procedure should be amended further, to provide for procedures in judicial review proceedings concerning District Council action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Rules of Procedure for the District Council be and the same hereby are repealed and readopted with the following amendments:
