WHEREAS	S, the County Executive has duly nominated Elizabeth M. Hewlett, a resident of
Bowie, to serve a	as a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission
and to serve on a	full-time basis as Chairperson of the Prince George's County Planning Board;

WHEREAS	S, a public hearing on the nomination and confirmation of Ms. Hewlett has been
held; and	
WHEREAS	S, the remaining four members of the Commission from Prince George's County

are residents of Temple Hills, Glenn Dale, Bowie, and Fort Washington respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that, with the appointment of Elizabeth M. Hewlett to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, there continues to be reasonable geographic distribution with respect to the places of residence of the members of the Commission from Prince George's County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Elizabeth M. Hewlett is hereby confirmed as a member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission and as Chairperson of the Prince George's County Planning Board, with a term expiring June 15, 2014.
