Commission for Families

FOR the purpose of expanding the membership of the Commission for Families Governing Board.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

Section 2-464,

The Prince George's County Code (1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 2-464 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

## SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

## DIVISION 37. COMMISSION FOR FAMILIES.

## Sec. 2-464. Commission for Families Governing Board; composition; terms; vacancies.

There is established a Commission for Families Governing The Board shall consist of [thirteen (13)] fifteen (15) members, all of whom shall be voting members: The Director of the Prince George's County Department of Social Services or designee of the Director; the Director of the Prince George's County Health Department or designee of the Director; the Director of the Juvenile Services Agency, Region VII, or designee of the Director; the Superintendent of the Prince George's County Public Schools or designee of the Superintendent; a representative appointed by the Secretary of the State Department of Human Resources; a representative appointed by the County Executive; a representative appointed by the County Council; and [six (6)] eight (8) citizens of the County who shall be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. [At least two (2) of the citizen representatives shall come from the geographic area impacted by the project.] The directors of the local agencies or their designees and the State designee shall be designated by their representative agencies and shall not be subject to the confirmation process. The County Executive shall designate one member to serve as Chairperson.
