BILL

AN ACT concerning

Juror Compensation

FOR the purpose of establishing the level of juror
compensation.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

Section 9,
Chapter 25,

Laws of Prince George's County, 1992.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 9 of Chapter 25 of the Laws of Prince George's County, 1992, as enacted by CB-45-1992, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

apter 25, Laws of Prince George's County, 1992.

SECTION 9. JUROR COMPENSATION. [For each day a juror attends court as a juror, the juror shall be paid \$10.00 expense money plus an additional \$3.00 expense money if the juror's service extends past 6:00 p.m. and a second additional \$3.00 if the juror's service extends past 9 p.m. on any day.] Juror compensation shall be as set forth in Section 8-106(b)(17) of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
