BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

Pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government Article, Section 9-1A-31, prior to any expenditure of local impact grant funds provided under Section 9-1A-27, a county shall develop, in consultation with the local development council, a multiyear plan for the expenditure of the local impact grant funds for services and improvements consistent with infrastructure, facilities, public safety, sanitation, economic and community development, including housing, and other public services and improvements. The proposed legislation establishes a process for the County to develop and review the multiyear plan.
