Staff summarized the purpose of the resolution and referral comments that were received. CR-71-2004 pertains to new fees for examination and training courses for public swimming pool operators. These fees were authorized under the provisions of CB-44-2004. The additional funds that will be generated have been included in the Health Department's FY 2005 budget submission.
