DESIGNATION OF AUGUST 10, 2010 AS LEGISLATIVE DAY NO. 23

Chair Dernoga designated August 10, 2010 as Legislative Day number 23.

1. <u>CONSIDERATION OF EXECUTIVE VETO</u>

Council Chair Dernoga offered the County Executive Liaison, Marcus Jackson, an opportunity to make comments on behalf of the County Executive and requested comments from Russell King, the County Attorney's Office. Neither offered additional information. Council Member Dean spoke to his reasons for supporting Council Bill 36 and supporting the veto override.

CB-36-2010 (DR-4) - AN ACT CONCERNING TAXICABS AND LIMOUSINES for the purpose of amending provisions of the Code regulating taxicabs, amending certain definitions and requirements for certificates of registration, licensees, fees and otherwise relating to the regulation of taxicabs. - **VETO OVERIDE CARRIED**

Enacted by the Council on 7/13/2010 by a 9-0 vote. In favor: Council Members Dernoga, Bland, Campos, Dean, Exum, Harrison, Knotts, Olson and Turner. Vetoed by the County Executive on 8/5/2010.
