**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Enactment of Certain Ordinances of the Town of Landover Hills

3 For the purpose of approving the enactment of Ordinance No. 99-O-12 amending Sections 9802  
4 and 9802.1 of the Code of the Town of Landover Hills concerning parking and Ordinance No.  
5 99-O-13 amending Sections 7404 and 2802 concerning residential driveways and penalties.

6 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Landover Hills duly enacted Ordinance  
7 No. 99-O-12 on November 15, 1999; and

8 WHEREAS, this Ordinance (which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as  
9 Attachment A, and hereinafter referred to as the "Ordinance") repealed and reenacted the Code  
10 of the Town of Landover Hills, Sections 9802 and 9802.1; and

11 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Landover Hills duly enacted Ordinance  
12 No. 99-O-13 on November 15, 1999; and

13 WHEREAS, this Ordinance (which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as  
14 Attachment B, and hereinafter referred to as the "Ordinance") repealed and reenacted the Code of  
15 the Town of Landover Hills, Sections 7404 and 2802; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code authorizes  
17 municipalities within the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan District to enact ordinances  
18 affecting parking on land either zoned for residential or commercial use or adjacent to residential  
19 or commercial zones for the purpose of preserving, improving and protecting the general  
20 character and design of lands within the corporate limits of the municipality, provided that such

1 ordinances impose stricter or additional limitations or restrictions than are otherwise imposed by  
2 the County zoning regulations; and

3 WHEREAS, Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the Maryland Annotated Code provides that  
4 such ordinance shall not be effective until approved by the County Council of Prince George's  
5 County, sitting as the District Council; and

6 WHEREAS, the Town of Landover Hills, pursuant to Section 8-112.1 of Article 28 of the  
7 Maryland Annotated Code, has delivered a certified copy of each Ordinance to the District  
8 Council; and

9 WHEREAS, the District Council has determined that the Ordinances impose additional  
10 conditions upon residential parking than those currently imposed by Subtitle 27 of the Prince  
11 George's County Code (the "Zoning Ordinance").

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
13 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington  
14 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Ordinance No. 99-O-12, as  
15 represented in Attachment A to this Resolution, and Ordinance No. 99-O-13, as represented in  
16 Attachment B to this Resolution, adopted by the Town of Landover Hills, be and are hereby  
17 APPROVED.
