**CHARTER AMENDMENT**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amendment of Section 505, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 505 of the Charter of Prince George's  
4 County to provide that an individual may be temporarily appointed to fill a vacancy, no more  
5 than one year, without an intervening permanent appointment.

6 BY proposing an amendment to:

7 Section 505,

8 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
10 Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 505, Charter of Prince George's County,  
11 Maryland, is hereby proposed:

12 **Section 505. Temporary Administrative Appointments.**

13 During the temporary absence of the Chief Administrative Officer or the head of an agency  
14 of the executive branch, or if such position shall become vacant, the County Executive shall  
15 make a temporary appointment to fill such position. No person shall serve as Acting Chief  
16 Administrative Officer or acting head of any agency for a period longer than sixty calendar days.  
17 Such limit may be extended an additional four calendar months by resolution of the Council. An  
18 individual may be temporarily appointed to fill a vacancy, no more than one year, without an  
19 intervening permanent appointment.

20 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the  
21 County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors

1 of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2018  
2 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.

3 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed  
4 Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election  
5 occurring on November 6, 2018, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:

7 PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT

8 To provide that an individual may be temporarily appointed to fill a  
9 vacancy, no more than one year, without an intervening permanent  
10 appointment.

12 Adopted this 24<sup>th</sup> day of July , 2018, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members  
13 of the full County Council.
