RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Public Facilities Element of the Preliminary Greenbelt Metro Area and MD 193

Corridor Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment

For the purpose of identifying inconsistencies between the Preliminary Greenbelt Metro Area and MD 193 Corridor Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment and existing or proposed State or County facilities, and approving the inclusion of any new transportation proposals prior to adoption of the preliminary Sector Plan by the Planning Board.

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2011, the District Council adopted CR-40-2011, initiating an amendment to the 1989 Approved Master Plan for Langley Park-College Park-Greenbelt and Vicinity; 1990 Adopted Sectional Map Amendment for Planning Areas 65, 66, and 67; 2001 Approved Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for the Greenbelt Metro Area; and 2002 Prince George's County Approved General Plan in order to develop a comprehensive approach to implement the recommendations of the 2002 General Plan, and to ensure that future development is consistent with County policies; and

WHEREAS, the sector plan area being part of Planning Area 67 is generally comprised of properties bounded by the Capital Beltway (I-95/I-495), Henry A. Wallace Beltsville Agricultural Research Center, and the historic center of Greenbelt to the north; the corporate boundaries of College Park to the west; the residential portion of the Town of Berwyn Heights, Greenbelt National Park, and the Hunting Ridge apartment complex to the south; and the Windsor Green and Greenbrook residential communities to the east; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland, requires the Prince George's Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to submit its proposals for public facilities in the plan to the District Council and to the County Executive prior to adoption by the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a review period for the County Executive and the District Council to review, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or transportation line unless the District Council, after consultation with the County Executive, approves (by resolution) the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board referred the public facilities element of the Preliminary Greenbelt Metro Area and MD 193 Corridor Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment for review, comments, and the identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities on July 20, 2012, attached hereto as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, upon review the District Council has concluded that, in general, the public facilities transportation proposals contained in the preliminary sector plan are consistent with the County's Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program ("CTP").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the transportation system and public facilities proposals in the public facilities element of the Preliminary Greenbelt Metro Area and MD 193 Corridor Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment, as transmitted on July 20, 2012, by the Prince George's Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, are hereby approved for inclusion in the preliminary plan.
