Dear Chair Burroughs:

Enclosed for consideration by the County Council is a contract between Prince George's County and **Motorola Solutions**, **Inc.** for *Combined Radio Maintenance and Records Management Maintenance*.

This contract ensures the continued maintenance and operational reliability of the County's public safety communications and data systems, including legacy software and hardware, licensing for radio communications, computer-aided dispatch, records management systems, and Next Generation 9-1-1. The contract term is from October 1, 2025, through June 30, 2030, with \$10,409,184 allocated in FY 2026 and an estimated total value of \$79,105,900 over the contract term.

Motorola Solutions has also committed to supporting the County's Local, Small, and Minority Business Enterprise (LSMBE) growth through strategic capacity-building initiatives over the five-year contract period. Highlights of their proposed community and workforce development commitments include:

Partnerships with Local Academic Institutions

- Bowie State University: Collaborate on experiential learning opportunities and career development programs.
- **Prince George's Community College:** Expand the existing co-op program and sponsor annual STEM scholarships.
- **Prince George's County Public Schools**: Provide internships, hands-on technology experiences, and summer camp support.

Development of County-Based and Minority Businesses

Motorola Solutions will provide free technical training on Motorola technologies to county-based small and minority-owned business enterprises (MBE) firms, along with opportunities for job shadowing, participation in 9-1-1 Center support services, and collaboration on public safety projects across the Mid-Atlantic region.
