BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of adding certain classes of work to the International Association of Fire
 4 Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Civilians) Salary Schedule “H” in accordance with Public
 5 Employee Relations Board (PERB) Representation Petition/Amendment #16 39 00280 90S.

6 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
 7 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code has, in order to
 8 provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments to the
 9 Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to certain classes of work described
 10 within Section 1 of this Bill; now, therefore,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 12 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby
 13 amended as follows:

6410H Heavy Equipment Mechanic I, H-15

(\$30,143 - \$61,242)

6412H Heavy Equipment Mechanic II, H-16

(\$31,615 - \$64,262)

6413H Heavy Equipment Mechanic III, H-17

(\$33,160 - \$67,431)

6424H Master Equipment Mechanic, H-19

(\$36,487 – \$74,255)

3317H Fire Inspector III, H-21

(\$40,154 - \$81,777)

14 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
15 calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to July 1, 2005.
