REPORT: COMMITTEE VOTE: Favorable, 4-0 (Councilmembers: Campos, Davis, Harrison, and Lehman)

This bill will provide that public notice and advertisement for all competitive bid contracts include a centralized website designated by the Purchasing Agent.

The Office of Law has reviewed this bill and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediment to its enactment.

The enactment of CB-108-2012 will not have an adverse fiscal impact on the County. The design and maintenance of the website will be with existing resources in the Office of Information Technology and Communications (OITC).
