RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Fiscal Year 2027 Federal and State Transportation Grant Application Authorization

For the purpose of authorizing the Director of the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation (DPW&T) to file applications for Fiscal Year 2027 to include, but not be limited to those with the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) and its' offices and modal administrations, including the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA), the Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) and the Maryland Highway Safety Office (MSHO); the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS); the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) and its' offices and modal administrations including the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA); the United States Department of Energy (DOE); the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOCG) or any other Federal or State agencies not identified in this listing.

WHEREAS the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) is the designated recipient in Maryland for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

WHEREAS MWCOCG is the designated recipient for the Enhanced Mobility Program and the Transportation Land-Use Connections Program grant; and

WHEREAS the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

WHEREAS the USDHS is the designated recipient for the Transit Security Grant Program under the Federal Transit Act; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration, the Administrator of Maryland Highway Safety Office, the Administrator of Maryland State Highway Administration, the Executive Director of the Metropolitan Council of Governments, and the Secretary of Homeland

Security are authorized to make grants to counties and local governments for mass transportation programs and/or projects, respectively; and

WHEREAS an application for financial assistance imposes certain obligations upon the applicant, which includes a local share of the costs for certain projects and/or programs; and

WHEREAS, the USDOT, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, requires an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act to give assurance that it will comply with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the filing of the aforesaid applications for Fiscal Year 2027 be endorsed.
