**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Air Conditioning, Refrigeration, and Heating Servicing

3 For the purpose of providing that a County permit is not required for certain work performed  
 4 pursuant to a permit issued by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 2A. AIR CONDITIONING, REFRIGERATION,  
 7 AND HEATING SERVICING.

8 Section 2A-104,

9 The Prince George's County Code

10 (1995 Edition, 1997 Supplement).

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
 12 Maryland, that Section 2A-104 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby  
 13 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

14 SUBTITLE 2A. AIR CONDITIONING, REFRIGERATION,  
 15 AND HEATING SERVICING.

16 **Sec. 2A-104. Permits.**

17 (a) Permits for work to be done in accordance with any codes governing the scope of work  
 18 permitted under this Subtitle shall not be issued except to a person holding a valid license as a  
 19 refrigeration, air conditioning and heating contractor or refrigeration and air conditioning  
 20 specialist contractor, or to a heating specialist contractor.

21 (b) Any refrigeration, air conditioning, or heating work for which any required permit has

1 not been issued, or which is not proceeding in accordance with the regulations governing the  
2 scope of the work permitted, may be stopped by the Director of the Department of  
3 Environmental Resources.

4 (c) A firm or individual licensed by the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission shall  
5 not be required to obtain a permit under this Subtitle to install and maintain gas-fired boiler  
6 appliances or other equipment, provided that the firm or individual has already obtained a permit  
7 for the same work from the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission.

8 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
9 calendar days after it becomes law.
