This resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule H for employees in the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF), AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Civilians) and reflects modifications of the two year Agreement. (July 1, 2003 – June 30, 2005).

The highlights of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are included in CB-19-2004.

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Civilians) for Fiscal Years 2004 and 2005.
