WHEREAS, CB-74-2022, the previous legislation, was passed with inaccurate language			
and is no longer needed or accurate as the State has passed new and improved framework for			
Prince George's to create BIDs; and			
WHEREAS, State legislation has lowered the threshold to create BID and will now allow			
the county to start the process; and			
WHEREAS, CB-74-2022 is not only inaccurate but no longer required.			
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's			
County, Maryland, that this current legislation would delete the Business Improvement District			
(BID) in Langley Par	k

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 10-339, 10, 340, 10-341, 10-342, 10-343, 10-344, 10-345, 10-346 and 10-347 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 10-339, 10, 340, 10-341, 10-342, 10-343, 10-344, 10-345, 10-346 and 10-347 of the Prince George's County Code be abrogated and is of no full force and effect.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
