SECTION 1	BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, sitting	as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional
District in Prince	George's County, Maryland, that Sections 27-11001, 27-2500, 27-5101,
27-5102, and 27-5	5402 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also

3	PART 27-1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.
4	SECTION 27-11000. REGULATIONS APPLICABLE IN ALL ZONES.
5	Sec. 27-11001. Prohibited Uses.
6	(a) The following uses are prohibited in all zones:
7	(1) The display or sale of drug paraphernalia.
8	(A) "Drug Paraphernalia" means all equipment, products, and materials of any
9	kind which, in violation of Title 5, Criminal Law Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, are used
10	in <u>:</u>
11	(i) planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, harvesting, manufacturing,
12	compounding, converting, producing, processing, preparing, testing, analyzing, packaging,
13	repackaging, storing, containing, or concealing a controlled dangerous substance; or
14	(ii) injecting, ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human
15	body a controlled dangerous substance [in violation of Subheading Health-Controlled Dangerous
16	Substances, Article 27, Annotated Code of Maryland. "Drug Paraphernalia" includes:]
17	[i.Kits used in planting, propagating, cultivating, growing, or harvesting of
18	any species of plant which is a controlled dangerous substance or from which a controlled
19	dangerous substance can be derived];
20	[ii.Kits used in manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing,
21	processing, or preparing controlled dangerous substances;]
22	[iii.Isomerization devices used in increasing the potency of any species of
23	plant which is a controlled dangerous substance;]
24	[iv.Testing equipment used in identifying or analyzing the strength,
25	effectiveness, or purity of controlled dangerous substances;]
26	[v.Scales and balances used in weighing or measuring controlled dangerous
27	substances;]
28	[vi.Dilutants and adulterants, such as quinine hydrochloride, mannitol,
29	mannite, dextrose, and lactose, used in cutting controlled dangerous substances;]
30	[vii.Separation gins and sifters used in cleaning or refining marijuana:]
31	[viii.Blenders, bowls, containers, spoons, and mixing devices used in

10	[(aa) Metal, wooden, acrylic, glass, stone, plastic, or ceramic pipes,
11	with or without screens, permanent screens, hashish heads, or punctured metal bowls;]
12	[(bb) Water pipes;]
13	[(cc) Carburetion tubes and devices;]
14	[(dd) Smoking and carburetion masks;]
15	[(ee) Roach clips (meaning objects used to hold burning material, such
16	as a marijuana cigarette, that has become too small or too short to be held in the hand);]
17	[(ff) Miniature cocaine spoons and cocaine vials;]
18	[(gg) Chamber pipes;]
19	[(hh) Carburetor pipes;]
20	[(ii) Electric pipes;]
21	[(jj) Air-driven pipes;]
22	[(kk) Chilams;]
23	[(ll) Bongs; and]
24	[(mm) Ice pipes or chillers.]
25	(B) In determining whether an object is drug paraphernalia, a court or other
26	authority shall consider, in addition to all other logically relevant factors, the [following:]-factors
27	in Title 5, Criminal Law Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.
28	[(i) Statements by an owner or by anyone in control of the object
29	concerning its use;]
30	[(ii) Prior convictions (if any) of an owner or anyone in control of the
31	object, under any State or Federal law relating to any controlled dangerous substance;]

2	violation of Subheading Health-Controlled Dangerous Substances, Article 27, Annotated Code

10	Dangerous Substances, Article 27, Annotated Code of Maryland. The innocence of an owner, or
11	of anyone in control of the object, as to a direct violation of that Subheading shall not prevent a
12	finding that the object is used as drug paraphernalia;]
13	[(vii) Instructions, oral or written, provided with the object concerning
14	its use;]
15	[(viii)Descriptive materials accompanying the object which explain or
16	depict its use;]
17	[(ix) National and local advertising concerning its use;]
18	[(x) The manner in which the object is displayed for sale;]
19	[(xi) Whether the owner, or anyone in control of the object, is a
20	legitimate supplier of similar or related items to the community, such as a licensed distributor or
21	dealer of tobacco products;]
22	[(xii) Direct or circumstantial evidence of the ratio of sales of the
23	object to the total sales of the business enterprise;]
24	[(xiii) The existence and scope of legitimate uses for the object in the
25	community; or]
26	[(xiv) Expert testimony concerning its use.]
27	(C) The definitions contained in [Article 27, Section 277, Annotated Code of
28	Maryland] Title 5, Criminal Law Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, are a part of this Section
29	to the same extent as if they were fully described in the Section.

4	(a) The plant Cannabis Sativa L. and any part of the plant, including all derivatives, extracts,

6	TetraHydrocannabinol concentration of greater than 0.3% on a dry weight basis.
7	(b)"Cannabis" includes Cannabis products.
8	(C)"Cannabis" does not include "hemp " or "hemp products," as defined in Agriculture
9	Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

11	[Medical cannabis dispensary] <u>Cannabis dispensary</u>
12	[An entity licensed under Subtitle 33 of the Health – General Article, Annotated Code of
13	Maryland, that acquires, possesses, repackages, processes, transfers, transports, sells, distributes,
14	or dispenses products containing usable medical cannabis, related supplies, or related products,
15	including tinctures, aerosols, oils, or ointments; or provides educational materials for use by a
16	qualifying patient or caregiver.]
17	A use which entails acquiring, possessing, repackaging, transferring, selling, distributing,
18	or dispensing Cannabis or Cannabis products, including tinctures, aerosols, oils, and ointments,
19	related supplies, and educational materials for use by a qualifying patient, caregiver, or adult
20	over the age of 21 through a storefront. Cannabis dispensary also includes a former medical
21	cannabis dispensary that converted its license to allow for the sale of both medical and adult use
22	cannabis pursuant to Alcoholic Beverages & Cannabis Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

24	[Medical cannabis finished product] <u>Cannabis finished product</u>
25	A product containing a [medical] cannabis concentrate or a [medical] cannabis-infused
26	product packaged and labeled for release to a qualifying patient , caregiver, or adult over the age
27	<u>of 21</u> .
28	* * * * * * * * *
29	[Medical cannabis grower and/or processor] <u>Cannabis grower</u>
30	[A medical cannabis grower is an entity licensed under Subtitle 33 of the Health – General
31	Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, that cultivates, manufactures, packages, processes, or

distributes medical cannabis to licensed processors, licensed dispensaries, or registered independent testing laboratories. A medical cannabis processor is an entity licensed under Subtitle 33 of the Health – General Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, that transforms medical cannabis into another product or extract, and packages and labels medical cannabis.]

A use that entails cultivating or packaging cannabis, as well as providing cannabis to other Cannabis uses and registered independent testing laboratories. Cannabis grower also includes a former medical cannabis grower that converted its license to allow for the growing of Cannabis for medical and adult use pursuant to the Alcoholic Beverages & Cannabis Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

Cannabis incubator

An entity licensed under the Alcoholic Beverages & Cannabis Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, to operate a facility within which Cannabis micro-dispensaries; Cannabis micro-growers; and/or Cannabis processors may operate.

Cannabis micro-dispensary

A use that entails acquiring, possessing, repackaging, transferring, selling, distributing, or dispensing Cannabis or Cannabis products, including tinctures, aerosols, oils, and ointments, related supplies, and educational materials for use by a qualifying patient, caregiver, or adult over the age of 21 solely through a delivery service or transport. Cannabis micro-dispensary is limited to ten (10) employees and may not have a physical storefront.

Cannabis micro-grower

A use that entails cultivating or packaging no more than 10,000 square feet of indoor cannabis canopy or 40,000 square feet of outdoor cannabis canopy, as well as providing cannabis to other Cannabis uses and registered independent testing laboratories.

Cannabis micro-processor

A use that entails transforming no more than 1,000 pounds of Cannabis per year into another product or extract, packaging and labeling the Cannabis product, and providing Cannabis to other Cannabis uses and registered independent testing laboratories.

Cannabis on-site consumption establishment

A use that entails distributing Cannabis or Cannabis products for on-site consumption other than consumption by smoking indoors.

Cannabis Processor

a use that entails transforming Cannabis into another product or extract, Packaging and labeling the cannabis product, and providing Cannabis to other Cannabis uses and registered independent testing laboratories. Cannabis processor also includes a former Medical cannabis processor that converted its license to allow for the processing of Cannabis for medical and adult use pursuant to Alcoholic Beverages & Cannabis Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of Section 27-5101, 27-5102, and 27-6305 shall be renumbered or reordered, as appropriate, to accommodate the incorporation of the provisions of this Ordinance and to be consistent with the tabulation conventions within the Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply prospectively. Any uses that were permitted and existing as of January 1, 2023, shall be deemed permitted uses and not nonconforming uses.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been adopted without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.
