RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments for the MD 202 Corridor
3 For the purpose of approving the Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments for the MD 202
4 Corridor, to amend the 1990 Approved Largo-Lottsford Master Plan (Planning Area 73), the
5 1993 Approved Landover and Vicinity Master Plan (Planning Area 72), and the Master Plan of
6 Transportation, as those plans concern transportation improvements at I-95 and Evarts
7 Street/Campus Way North at I-95 and Arena Drive, and at the MD 202-Lottsford Road
8 intersection.

9 WHEREAS, the comprehensive planning process provides for minor public facility plan
10 amendments, to change the long-range land use plans while ensuring that future development
11 will be in accordance with principles of orderly comprehensive land use planning, as expressed
12 in the master plans; and

13 WHEREAS, the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, with the
14 concurrence of the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District
15 Council, initiated preparation of the Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments for the MD 202
16 Corridor in May 2000; and

17 WHEREAS, as part of the procedure for preparation of minor public facility plan
18 amendments, the Planning established goals, concepts, and guidelines, which were approved by
19 the District Council on November 20, 2001; and

20 WHEREAS, the District Council and the Planning Board held a joint public hearing and
21 received testimony on the Preliminary Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments on April 30,

2002; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board held a worksession on the testimony from the joint public hearing and on May 23, 2002 adopted the Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments, described in Planning Board Resolution PGCPB No. 02-99; and

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2002, the District Council conducted a worksession on the adopted Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments, to review the public hearing testimony.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Adopted Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments for the MD 202 Corridor are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff is authorized to make appropriate text and map revisions to correct identified errors, reflect updated information, and incorporate the changes resulting from prior Council actions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
