AFFECTED CODE SECTIONS:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan provides for four cycles of category change requests annually to amend the Plan. This Resolution represents the September 2021 Cycle of Amendments.

The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan was adopted by CR-64-2019, and amended by CR-75-2019, CR-11-2020, CR-45-2020, CR-87-2020, CR-98-2020, CR-22-2021, CR-49-2021 and CR-87-2021.

There is one (1) category change requests located in the Parkway sewer basis, one (1) in the Western Branch sewer basin, three (3) in the Piscataway sewer basin, and two (2) in the Mattawoman sewer basin.

Environment Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5, of the Maryland Annotated Code, sets procedures for amendments and revisions to the Plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing on the amendments, the County Council must submit to the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission a copy of the resolution for their recommendations.
