Dear Chair Oriadha:

Enclosed for the County Council's consideration is a Resolution regarding a supplemental to the Local Impact Grant (LIG) Funds Multiyear Plan in the amount of \$4,053,700.

Pursuant to CB-88-2015, and subsequent to the Local Development Council's review, comment, and recommendations on the multiyear plan, the County Executive is required to transmit the plan to the County Council for review and approval by resolution. The Local Development Council has completed its review and transmitted its recommendations; therefore, this supplemental plan now requires final approval by the County Council, consistent with prior practice.

This supplemental reflects an update to the Fiscal Year 2026 spending plan and specifies the use of LIG funds consistent with State Government Article, Section 9-1A-31, which provides that such funds shall be used for improvements in communities in immediate proximity to video lottery facilities, including investments in public safety, economic and community development, and other essential public services.

The enclosed supplemental allocates \$4,053,700 in Community Impact Grant funding to:

- Victory Church International DBA Greater Works Ministries to support the Youth Jobs and Apprenticeship Program, Youth Leadership Academy, scholarships, and community-based programming serving District 8 residents.

This investment advances the County's continued commitment to youth development, workforce readiness, and community-based programming that delivers direct, measurable impact for residents. It builds upon previously approved FY 2026 investments and ensures that resources are deployed in a manner that is both responsive to community needs and aligned with the County's broader strategic priorities.

As with prior LIG plans, this supplemental bill reflects a people-centered approach to funding that prioritizes opportunity, public safety, and long-term community stability, while maintaining consistency with the Council-approved FY 2026 budget framework.
