PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 10/3/03

Committee Vote, Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Councilmembers, Exum, Bland, Hendershot, Knotts and Peters.)

This legislation will provide for Exempt Service positions in the Police Department pursuant to Section 902 of the Charter of Prince George's County. The Police Department states that these positions are needed to assist in achieving its mission.

The two positions requested to be in the Exempt Services are 2522G Administrative Specialist III, G-33, position numbers 03304 and 03305.

There will be a negative fiscal impact on the County in the amount of approximately \$42,000 related to the fringe benefit cost of establishing two exempt positions at \$90,000 per year.
