<u>(4)</u>	A new Subsection 108.2.2, titled "Expiration of permit; correction of code	
violations," is a	added to read as follows: Any permit issued for residential property to correct a

building code or housing code violation, issu	ed pursuant to Subtitle 4 or Subtitle 13 of this Code		
shall be issued only for a period of time reason	onably necessary to correct the violation, not to		
exceed 90 days. The initial period of the permit shall be established by the Building Official			
based upon the extent of the work required to correct the violation. The permit may be extended			
or renewed for an additional period of 180 days if, in the opinion of the Building Official, the			
applicant has demonstrated substantial progress to complete the work in accordance with the			
permit and has demonstrated substantial justi	ification for failure to complete the work within the		
period of the permit. The Board of Appeals shall have no authority to grant an extension to the			
period of the permit.			
SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENAC	CTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)		
calendar days after it becomes law.
