1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of adding a class title and grade for a certain class of work to the bargaining unit
4 represented by the Police Civilian Employee's Association (Senior Emergency Dispatch Aides).5 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
6 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has in order to
7 provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council an amendment to the
8 Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland which would add a certain class of
9 work described in Section 1 of this bill; and10 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County
11 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has
12 recommended to the County Council an amendment to the Classification Plan for Prince
13 George's County, Maryland with respect to the class of work described in Section 1 of this bill,
14 subject to an Amendment of Certification by the Prince George's County Public Employee
15 Relations Board (PERB) and pursuant to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Prince
16 George's County, Maryland and the Police Civilian Employee's Association for positions in the
17 bargaining unit represented by Police Civilian Employee's Association (Senior Emergency
18 Dispatch Aides); now, therefore;19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
20 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby

1 amended subject to an Amendment of Certification by the PERB and pursuant to the
2 aforementioned collective bargaining agreement as follows:

3 3398P Senior Emergency Dispatch Aide, P-13
4 (\$25,134 - \$37,980)

5 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
6 calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to July 1, 2001.
