Section 814 of the County Charter provides for the financing of capital projects pursuant to the passage of enabling legislation. Section 323 of the County Charter provides for the Council to refer to the voters of the County any act enabling the County to borrow money to finance capital projects. Each enabling act shall authorize borrowing for either a single capital project or a number of projects of the same generic class.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

This bill, if approved by the voters at the next general election, will provide the County with enabling authority to sell \$799,000 to replace and renovate major building components of several facilities at Prince George's Community College. This legislation contains the enabling authority required to implement the programming schedule which is described in the Adopted FY1991-FY1996 Capital Improvement Program for fiscal years 1991 and 1992.
