## LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE REPORT DATE: 5/1/90

Committee Vote: Favorable, 6-0 (In favor: Council Members Bell,

Casula, Castaldi, Mills, Pemberton and Wilson)

This bill adopt and approve the collective bargaining agreement contained in CR-34-1990 and CR-35-1990.

The Office of Law has reviewed this legislation and find it to be in proper legislative form without legal impediments to its enactment.

The fiscal impact on the County is negative in the amount of \$13,608,535 as a result of adopting CR-34, CR-35 and CB-43-1990.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

Prince George's County and Local 1619, International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) have completed labor negotiations on a new three-year labor agreement for Fiscal Years 1990 through 1992, which covers fire fighters and paramedics in the Fire Department. This Bill is to adopt and approve the collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Section 16-233 (e) of the Personnel Law.

The fiscal impact of this agreement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
