RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Acting Chief of Police

3 For the purpose of extending the appointment of Lieutenant Colonel Gerald M. Wilson as Acting
4 Chief of Police.

5 WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Charter of Prince George’s County, Maryland provides for
6 the County Executive to make a temporary appointment to the position of head of any agency of
7 the Executive Branch if such a position shall become vacant; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 505 further provides that such appointment may be extended an
9 additional four calendar months by resolution of the County Council; and

10 WHEREAS, by Executive Order No. 2-2002, Lieutenant Colonel Gerald M. Wilson was
11 appointed Acting Chief of Police, effective March 1, 2002; and

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
13 County, Maryland, that the appointment of Lieutenant Colonel Gerald M. Wilson as Acting
14 Chief of Police be and the same is hereby extended for a period of up to four calendar months
15 from the date of this Resolution.
