AN ACT concerning

Taxicab Certificates

FOR the purpose of providing for the transfer of a taxicab certificate issued to a person to a partnership, company or corporation owned in whole or in part by the person.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 20. TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE.

Section 20-155,

The Prince George's County Code (1987 Edition, 1990 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 20-155 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and

reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 20. TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE.

DIVISION 6. REGISTRATION OF TAXICABS AND LIMOUSINES.

Sec. 20-155. Transfer of certificates.

- (a) When the owner of a vehicle registered under these regulations has transferred the title of the vehicle to a new owner, or has otherwise relinquished the use of the vehicle for hire, upon sufficient proof thereof to the Director, the certificate holder may have the certificate transferred to another vehicle to be used by him for hire in accordance with this Subtitle and State law, and thereupon the Director, upon receipt of payment of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), shall issue a new certificate to the owner for the replacement vehicle for the balance of the registration year, provided that the replacement vehicle meets all the requirements of this Subtitle.
- (b) The certificate holder for a vehicle registered under these regulations may have the certificate transferred to a partnership, company, corporation, or other organization in which the certificate holder is an owner. The Director, upon receipt of payment of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), shall issue a new certificate in the name of the partnership, company, corporation or other organization for the balance of the registration year, provided that the partnership, company, corporation or other organization meets all the requirements of this Subtitle.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
