CHARTER AMENDMENT

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Amendment of Section 304, Charter of Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of proposing an amendment to Section 304 of the Charter of Prince George's  
4 County to provide that the County is divided into nine Council districts that are compact,  
5 contiguous, and equal in population.

6 BY proposing an amendment to:

7 Section 304,

8 Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
10 Maryland, that the following amendment to Section 304, Charter of Prince George's County,  
11 Maryland, is hereby proposed:

12 Section 304. Council Districts.

13 (a) Prince George's County is hereby divided into nine Council districts that are compact,  
14 contiguous, and equal in population.

15 (b) The boundaries of the Council districts shall be established pursuant to the provisions  
16 of Section 305 of this Charter prior to the filing dates for the 1982 General Election to become  
17 effective on noon of the first Monday in December, 1982.

18 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that a copy of this Act be transmitted to the  
19 County Executive for publication and that a copy also be transmitted to the Board of Supervisors  
20 of Elections for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters of this County at the 2018  
21 General Election pursuant to Section 1105 of the Charter.

1 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the question of adoption of this proposed  
2 Charter Amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the County at the General Election  
3 occurring on November 6, 2018, and shall be placed on the ballot in the following form:
