RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Municipal Annexation

For the purpose of petitioning the chief executive and administrative officer of the City of College Park for referendum on certain resolutions of annexation.

WHEREAS, Article 23A, Section 19 of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for the annexation of land into a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City of College Park considered a petition for annexation into the City by the owners of an uninhabited parcel of commercial property approximately 24.5 acres in size abutting Cherry Hill Road in the unincorporated area of Prince George's County adjacent to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of College Park adopted Resolution 95-R-6 on October 10, 1995; and

WHEREAS, Article 23A, Section 19(h) provides that at any time within the 45-day period following final enactment of the resolution of annexation, the governing body of the county or counties in which the municipality is located, by at least a two-thirds majority vote, may petition the chief executive and administrative officer of the municipal corporation for a referendum on the resolution; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Prince George's County, Maryland desires that the question of annexation into a municipality be decided by a majority vote of the persons directly affected by the proposed annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that chief executive and administrative officer of the City of College Park are hereby petitioned pursuant to the provisions of Article 23A, Section 19, Annotated Code of Maryland, for a referendum on Resolution 95-R-6.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council is directed to transmit a copy of this Resolution to the chief executive and administrative officer of the City of College Park.
