PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 6/24/99

Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0, (Council Members Scott, Hendershot, Maloney and Russell).

This bill will remove obsolete references to the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department from the County Code. All references to the Takoma Part Volunteer Fire Department are to be deleted from the Section entitled "Benefits to Fire Companies and Rescue Squads", since Takoma Park has been annexed to Montgomery County. Individuals who began to receive benefits prior to the effective date of the annexation will continue to receive them.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-39-1999.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This legislation will remove obsolete references to the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department in Section 11-327 of the Prince George=s County Code. All references to the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department need to be deleted from the Section entitled “Benefits to Fire Companies and Rescue Squads”, since Takoma Park has been annexed to Montgomery County.
